Double Stitch or Oblong Cross

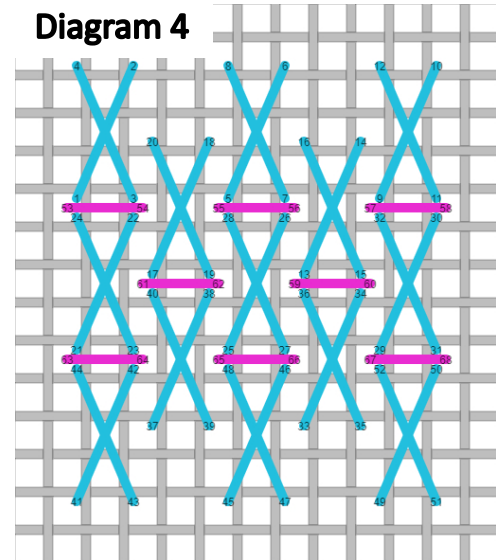


This is one of my favorite stitches and is diverse allowing you to change shape the size. Being able to stitch this in two colors or even shade the “small cross stich” inside can give you a huge amount of depth. Turn it sideways for a totally different look. I like to use this for leaves, clothing, or small areas that need small areas of pattern. Graph 2 has sequins between the oblong crosses allowing you to **BLING** it up! Remember that you are crossing over twice so you won't need as much thread. **Example:** normally if you use 4 strands of Splendor then you would only need 2 strands. This can be worked on a diagonal too... but it is not for the weak stitcher (LOL) its hard to do!

Threads to use: Use a stand-able thread for the large “X” and a metallic like Kreinik #8 braid for the small ‘x’.

Stay Safe and wash your hands! We will be producing the cleanest needlepoint in history!
