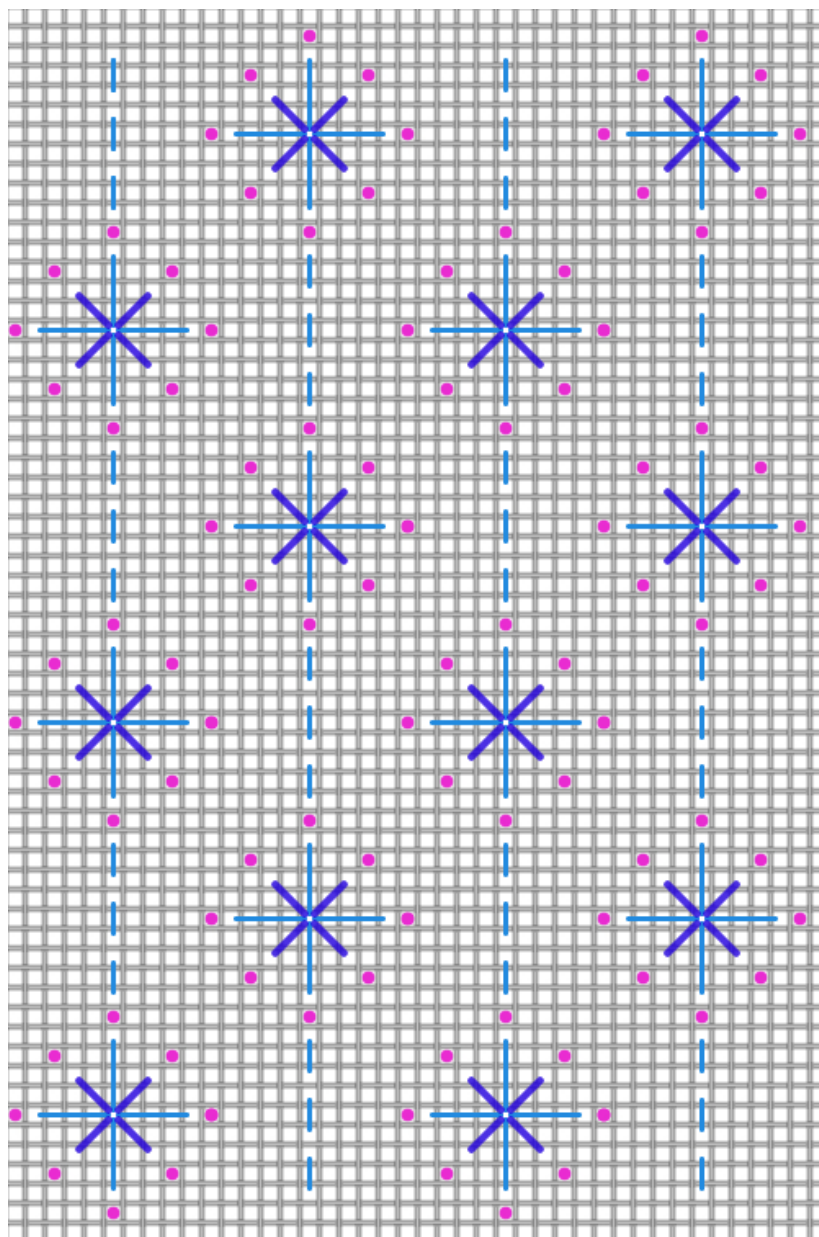


Lesson 6

It's the second week of the Quarantine class and for this lesson I thought it would be fun to share with you a background stitch created for these snowmen pictured below. I have used this stitch a lot for designs that are winter related. It can be diagramed smaller, you can take out the beads, or try using two light colors of metallic like #8 Pale Blue 194 & #8 Marshmallow white 5760. By using a smaller thread like #4 Braid the visual impact will be much softer. If you have a small area you can move these columns closer together as well. This can be a high impact stitch so be careful where you put it... if it the first thing you see it's probably not the best choice. Backgrounds can be very tricky you want a stitch that does not dominate the design.



Diagram #1



Work the light blue first which is #8 Kreinik 5760, the dark blue in the diagram is a 3mm white bugle bead. The pink dot is a white pearl #11 bead in a brick stitch.
